

July 7, 2016

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on July 7, 2016 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Steve & Carolyn Bupp and John Amspacher.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Carolyn Bupp and the Township secretary are recording the meeting.

The minutes were approved as presented.

Lamar announced that there will be an executive session after the meeting tonight.

Charlie made a motion to appoint Patrick Buhl as an alternate SEO, seconded by Bob the motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bob Gladfelter reported that Laverne Wolfgang will be retiring in October. Bob asked if the other Supervisors would like to replace Laverne with a full time employee or hire someone part time to help as needed. Laverne is interested in helping part time but doesn't want to plow snow. After some discussion the Board decided to try with part time help. Bob will contact Dan Forry to see if he is interested in helping with snow removal.

The Board discussed the bond for the Sewer Authority. Bob made a motion to move forward with the General Obligation Bond. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The Board discussed the proposed ordinance. Bob feels more changes are needed. Bob said that festivals and agricultural promotional events are two different. Ag promotional events should not be limited to one per year and a 72 hour time period. Bob gave some examples of why this ordinance as it will not work. Bob asked why we are trying to put a limit on Ag promotional events. Lamar said that it should be spelled out what is considered an Ag promotional event and what is considered a festival. The Board will send this ordinance back to the Planning Commission.

Carolyn Bupp stated if the Township would consider adopting an agri-tourism ordinance this items would be covered.

Bob reported that the road crew has been working on Ridge Road and Buffalo Valley Rd. Paving work is starting on July 8, 2016.

Bob informed the Board that Levi Rohrbaugh needs to do 15 hours of community service for 4-H. Levi is going to paint the dugouts at the park. Bob will have Dave Rehbein supervise and show Levi what to do.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The Board went into executive session at 8:25 P.M. to discuss litigation.

The executive session adjourned at 8:45 P.M.
