The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on December 8, 2010. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Bill Fogle, Attorney John Herrold, Bob Namovicz, Sean & Mike Mathias, Carisa Kreichaus and Corporal Taylor of PA State Police.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Brian made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Bob Namovicz gave an update on the sewer plant project.

Bob also ask that the Board not renew the junk yard license for Amspacher's junk yard. Bob was told that this junkyard is grandfathered in.

The Board spoke to Corporal Taylor concerning the truck traffic on Shaffers Church Road. If a traffic study is done by York County Planning a weight limit is set and posted the State Police can enforce the weight limit.

Sean and Michael Mathias presented their final subdivision plan. The stormwater plan is not completed yet but Sean has a signed contract for his house.

Carisa Kreichaus of the Codorus Estates Home Owners Association would like to request traffic studies for speed limits to be posted on Codorus Lane and Hillside Terrace. The Board will request that the York County Planning Commission conduct these studies.

Attorney Herrold reported that the last thing that occurred on the matter between Lisa Zartman and Donald Steger was on October 4, 2009.

Brian made a motion to approve that letters be sent to the Auditors regarding some rules that the Board would like to be followed starting in January of 2011. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar made a motion to adopt the budget for 2011, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
