The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on March 4, 2010 at 7:30 P.M. Board member present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang, Bill Fogle, Rob Wood, Ron Chittum, Beverly & Clarence Ehrhart, Greg Shaffer, Jerry Stump and Larry Kunkle.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Rob Wood was present regarding his outdoor amusement permit. The Board thinks it would be in Mr. Wood's best interest to come to the next meeting when the Township Attorney is present.

Beverly & Clarence Ehrhart, Greg Shaffer, Larry Kunkle and Ron Chittum all residents of Jefferson Road were present to speak to the board about the storm water problem at their homes. The water is running off from the field at the corner of S.R. 516 and Glen Echo Road. The Board is aware of the problem. The Board has been in contact with state representatives, Penn Dot, and the York County Conservation District. The Board has been told that it is the responsibility of the Township to handle this problem. Lamar intends to speak to Denise Myers and Steve Gantz to see if work can be on their properties to better direct the water runoff. The residents do plan on pursuing this with Penn Dot.

Keith Kreisel presented his proposal for a Township website. The proposed price for the website is \$2,500.00. Lamar made a motion to accept the proposal, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Laverne Wolfgang gave the Roadmaster report. The road crew has been working on repairs from the snowstorms.

The Township has gone over the amount of salt bid for the 2009- 2010 season. Phone quotes for 100 tons of deicing salt were obtained. Cargill quoted \$79.25 per ton. American Rock Salt quoted \$82.43 per ton and International salt was not interested in quoting. Bob made a motion to accept the quote of Cargill. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report. Bill reported that the Zoning Hearing was held for the Waste Water Treatment plant pump station was held on March 2, 2010. The pump station was approved.

Bob Gladfelter on reported on the Township pension fund.
