

June 9, 2010

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on June 9, 2010 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, James Bailey, Cecile Fetters, Roland & Patricia Cumor, Ann & Jerry Jones and Bill Fogle.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were presented to the Board. The second sentence of the fourth paragraph should read splits Codorus Township and Shrewsbury Township. Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as corrected. Brian seconded the motion.

Lamar announced that an executive session was held prior to tonight's meeting and the board will hold another executive session after tonight's meeting.

Attorney Herrold present ordinance 10-2 vacating a portion of Ressler Road. This portion of road is approximately .22 miles. Bob made a motion to adopt ordinance 10-2, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

William Curry was present to discuss the hearing that was held at the magistrate regarding his septic system. The Board would like to discuss this further with Bill Deal.

Patricia was before the board to discuss problems at the Davis property. The single family home has been changed into 2 apartments. There are 2 meter boxes. Walls have been installed to separate the 2 apartments. There are 2 kitchens and 2 separate entrances. There is still a problem with cars parking on the Cumors driveway. There are at least 7 cars using the Cumors private driveway. An access road has also been taken off of the Cumors driveway. Attorney Herrold will meet with Bill Fogle to discuss this issue in more detail.

The Board would like to implement some rules for the Township auditors. Attorney Herrold will look into this.

Brian said he was contacted by Lori Glatfelter about her neighbor's yard. The grass and weeds are very high. The Township does not have an ordinance for high grass & weeds.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:15 P.M.

The Board went into executive session.
