The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

John Soltes presented his final subdivision plan for a one lot subdivision. Bob made a motion to approve and sign the plan, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Laverne gave the Roadmaster report. New tires were purchased for the Ford Dump truck. Work is continuing on Johnson Road. Chemung is running a sale on chains for the trucks. Laverne was told to purchase the chains that are needed.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report. Bill had several complaints for water runoff at the job site of the Lutheran Church on Sticks Road. The residents were told to contact Karen Ward at the York County Conservation District. Bill also received a complaint from a resident that Richard Trump was dumping fill and rocks into the creek. This person was referred to Karen Ward as well. Bill made a visit to the Steger property to look at the property set back for the garage. Going by the pins that were present Bill said the garage is within the 10ft setback required by the ordinance.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
