The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on December 1, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang, Robert Fisher, Robert Tumberlinson, Steve Gantz, Andy Gantz & Tom Divans.

The meeting opened with the Pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Robert Tumberlinson was before the Board concerning the lights at Saint Jacobs Lutheran Church. Since he was at the last meeting the lights are not on all night. They go off at 10:00 P.M. and come back on at 5:00 A.M. The lights still shine into his windows. Lamar spoke to Sidney Krebs and was told the lights are needed for security. Robert would like to know if shields could be placed on the lights that shine down on his house.

Robert Fisher had questions about the stormwater problems at the church. Mr. Fisher would like to know who to contact if problems exist after the contractor is finished. Mr. Fisher was told he can contact the Township.

Steve & Andy Gantz were present to discuss the mobile home that Steve has on his property. He was sent a letter to remove the mobile home by December 6, 2011. He is not able to meet this deadline and would like to request an extension. The Board will give him an extension till March 1st. Steve will need to remove the mobile home or start a subdivision plan.

Laverne Wolfgang gave the Roadmaster report. The men have been working on tree trimming pipe cleaning and washouts. Laverne said the backhoe needs new tires. The cost is approximately \$1,500.00. Laverne was told to order the tires.

Tom Divans was before the Board with a request for guide rails on S.R. 216 near Snyder's Feed Mill. His wife was in an accident there and went off the road because there were no guide rails. Since this is a state road Penn Dot will need to be contacted.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 P.M.
