The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on May 4, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Kaltreider and Bob Gladfelter. Others present were: April Rehbein, Bill Fogle, Randy Sterner and Bob Namovicz.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Randy gave an update of the emergency management quarterly meeting. Randy has been in contact with Pat Isch regarding the comfort stations. Pat will be offering a training class in the fall for people interested in helping at the comfort stations.

Bill Fogle gave the zoning officer report. Bill reported that he had sent William Graf a violation for junk cars. Mr. Graf's garage roof caved in but, he is working on the cleaning up.

Bob Gladfelter reported that the road crew will be planting shrubs around the pump station at Codorus Estates. The maintenance of this area will be contracted out. Bob also reported that Monroe Bush is donating 5-6 oak trees to be transplanted at the park.

The Board discussed the repayment of the general fund C.D. in the amount of \$116,960.75 that was used for the park project. Starting this year the recreation fund will pay back \$25,000 per year until paid back in full.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
