

April 7, 2011

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on April 7, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter, and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang and Bill Fogle.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Brian made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bids were opened for two paving projects on Shaffers Church Road., stone and E-3.

The bids for Shaffers Church Road project #1 were opened and read as follows:

Stewart & Tate bid \$70.50 per ton for Superpave scratch course 9.5 mm and \$59.99 per ton for Superpave binder course 19 mm for a total bid of \$82,829.48.

Bituminous Paving bid \$55.90 per ton for Superpave scratch course 9.5 mm and \$49.80 per ton for Superpave binder course 19 mm for a total bid of \$69,846.10.

Kinsley Material bid \$64.30 per ton for Superpave scratch course 9.5 mm and \$56.30 per ton for Superpave binder course 19 mm for a total bid of \$79,553.10.

Shiloh Paving bid \$64.14 per ton for Superpave scratch course 9.5 mm and \$56.72 per ton for Superpave binder course 19 mm for a total bid of \$79,804.34

The bids for Shaffers Church Road project #2 were opened and read as follows:

Stewart & Tate bid \$71.75 per ton for Superpave scratch course 9.5 mm and \$59.25 per ton for Superpave binder course 19 mm for a total bid of \$111,093.25.

Bituminous Paving bid \$56.90 per ton for Superpave scratch course 9.5 mm and \$50.80 per ton for Superpave binder course 19 mm for a total bid of \$92,054.40.

Kinsley Material bid \$64.75 per ton for Superpave scratch course 9.5 mm and \$56.00 per ton for Superpave binder course 19 mm for a total bid of \$102,879.00.

Shiloh Paving bid \$64.25 per ton for Superpave scratch course 9.5 mm and \$56.76 per ton for Superpave binder course 19 mm for a total bid of \$103,321.12.

Brian made a motion to award the bids for Shaffers Church Road project #1 and project #2 to the low bidder, Bituminous Paving.

Lamar made a motion to award the stone bid to the low bidder, Vulcan Materials. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bids were opened and read for the E-3 Emulsion as follows:

Hammaker East bid \$2.12 per gallon for a total of \$84,800.00
HRI Inc. bid \$2.474 per gallon for a total of \$98,960.00

Bob made a motion to award the bid for E-3 Emulsion to the low bidder, Hammaker East. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Laverne gave the Roadmaster report. The road crew has been grading dirt roads. Work will begin on Shaffers Church Road next week to replace pipes and prepare the road for paving.

Bill Fogle gave the Zoning Officer report. Bill will be taking some people to the magistrate that have not responded to enforcement notices he has sent out.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 10:11 P.M.
