The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on March 9, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang, Bill Fogle, Bob Namovicz and Loren Riebling.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bob Namovicz gave a report on the sewer plant project. Bob also would like the Township to consider planting bushes where there is a drift zone to keep snow from drifting onto the roads. The dangerous building ordinance was also discussed. The Board explained that the ordinance has not been enforced due to the cost of removing the buildings.

Loren Riebling discussed the Watertank Road bridge project. Loren has been informed that the bridge does not meet the criteria for the federal bridge project. Loren is seeking support from Ron Miller and Todd Platts to resolve this matter.

Laverne Wolfgang gave the Roadmaster report. Laverne presented the proposal for the Shaffers Church Road project. The roadcrew have been working on potholes and trimming trees.

Bill Fogle reported that he has been looking into several properties with junk cars on their property. He will be sending out violation notices.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
