The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on October 12, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Kaltreider and Bob Gladfelter. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney John Herrold, Blaine Markel, Jenny Smith and Bob Schaefer.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Jenny Smith, Bob Schaefer and several other residents of Codorus Estates were present to talk about the walking trail. The Home Owners Association would like to be informed about the walking trail. Blaine Markel of James Holley and Associates explained what is planned for the walking trail. Since the storms have washed away portions of the trail some portions of the trail will be paved. Some grading will also be done. Kinsley has been contracted to do the work.

Attorney Herrold reported that Ralph and Stephanie Duncan have not responded to his letter asking for payment for the closing of a portion of Fair School Rd. Brian made a motion to authorize Attorney Herrold to file a complaint against Ralph and Stephanie Duncan with the Magistrate. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The Jefferson/Codorus Joint Sewer Authority made a request that the Codorus Township road crew plow the road to the sewer plant. Lamar will take a look at the road with Laverne before making a decision.

Lamar reported that the infield mix has been placed on the big ball diamond and seeding has also been done.

Bob met with Mike Hollins to discuss trees for the park. Mike said if we plant bushes and trees that are beneficial to wildlife we may be able to get a grant for the walking path and pavilion. Bob will have Mike work up a plan.

The bills were presented to the Board. Brian made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 P.M.
