

June 2, 2011

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on June 2, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang, Attorney John Herrold and Tom Wolfe.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were corrected to read that Brian seconded the motion to pay the bills instead of Bob. The minutes were approved as corrected.

Tom Wolfe of Springfield Township was present to discuss the Springfield Lane Bridge. Tom said he found out the bridge does not need to be replaced at this time as long as some maintenance is done to the bridge. The maintenance will cost between \$40,000 and \$50,000. The Board is still not interested in keeping the bridge open. Tom questioned if Springfield could pay the whole amount and keep the bridge open. Lamar feels it is a shared bridge and the cost should be shared, however if Springfield wants to pay the full amount to keep the bridge maintained that will be fine.

Attorney Herrold discussed the letter received from Ralph Duncan demanding a written apology and \$25,000 compensation for harassment and abusive treatment. Attorney Herrold will contact Mr. Duncan concerning this matter.

Laverne gave the Roadmaster report. The tar & chip work is approximately half way finished. The pick up is in the shop. The turbo charger needing to be replaced. There is a leak on the mower tractor. Stephenson Equipment will be down to look at it.

Three quotes were presented to the Board for Calcium Chloride as follows:

Recon quoted 1.09 per gallon for 6,500 gallons
JMG quoted 1.00 per gallon for 6,500 gallons
Calcium Chloride Sales quoted .95 per gallon for 6,500 gallons.

Bob made a motion to accept the quote of Calcium Chloride Sales, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Two quotes were presented to the Board for line painting as follows:

D.E. Gemmill quoted 0.058 per lineal feet
Alpha Space Control Co. Inc. quoted 0.051 per lineal feet

Bob made a motion to accept the quote of Alpha Space Control Co. Inc., seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bill Fogle reported that he has not issued any permits since the last meeting. He reported that the SPCA has removed all the horses from Fran Langrill's property.

Lamar made a motion to appoint Rick Sechrist to a new term on the Planning Commission, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar reported that Bob Namovicz is putting his house on the market and will no longer be able to serve on the Sewer Authority after his term ends in December. If he sells his house before then, he will need to resign. The Supervisors will start looking for a replacement.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:40 P.M.
