The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on April 13, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Bill Fogle, David Hoover and Attorney John Herrold.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

There was one correction to the minutes. The total bid in paragraph six should read 85, 829.48. Brian made a motion to accept the minutes as approved. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

David Hoover was present to request a hidden driveway sign at the property he rents from Titus Bortner on Jefferson Road. Penn Dot has been contacted. Penn Dot stated there was never a driveway permit issued for this property. The driveway will not meet Penn Dot specs and would need to be moved further south before signs could be considered. David was told the Township cannot erect signs without Penn Dot approval.

Attorney Herrold reported that there is nothing in the Duncan/Seelig agreement regarding the closure of the Township's end of Deerfield Rd. The Township should check with the fire companies before proceeding.

Lamar gave an update on the Township Park. A chain link fence will be installed and a Jiffy John will be placed at the small ball field.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:15 P. M.
