The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on November 9, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, David Mummert, Cary Rothman and Attorney John Herrold.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Cary Rothman was present to follow up on the enforcement notice that was sent to Christopher Mettee. Mr. Mettee has sent a letter to the Township appealing the enforcement notice. However, he did not send a check for the \$650.00 filing fee. The secretary will call Mr. Mettee and tell him he needs to send in a check or the Township will move forward with the enforcement proceedings.

Ordinance 11-5 for the York Area Tax Bureau mandated by Act 32 was presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to adopt the ordinance, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold followed up with Ralph Duncan concerning the payment for Fair School Road. Dr. Duncan would like to know how much the Board wants him to pay. The Board would like him to pay \$2,831.66, which is the same amount that was paid by Walter Seelig.

A final bill was presented to the Board for the park construction. Lamar made a motion to pay the Abel Construction bill, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar made a motion to appoint Chad Farmer to another term on the Township Recreation Board. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar made a motion to appoint Tom Insley to the Jefferson- Codorus Joint Sewer Authority. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:15 P.M.
