

February 3, 2011

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on February 3, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Kaltreider and Bob Gladfelter. Others present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang, Scott Zeigler, Sean & Mike Mathias, Rich Colton and Carisa Kreichauf.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Brian made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Rich Colton presented the final subdivision plan for Keith Hartman on Krebs Road. The subdivision and recreation fees have not been paid for this plan. The Board will sign the plan after the fees have been paid.

Carisa Kreichauf presented a letter to the board that has been mailed to the residents of Codorus Estates concerning the trash problem and the parking problems during snow or ice. There are still a few residents parking on the roads. The Board will check with Attorney Herrold to see what can be done.

Laverne Wolfgang gave the roadmaster report. Mid-Atlantic salt is unable to fulfill the Township's salt order. Laverne contacted three companies for phone quotes as follows: KBS 93.00 per ton, Cargill 79.50 per ton, American Rock Salt did not have anyone available to give a quote. Laverne ordered 100 tons of salt from Cargill. The men have replaced the copper plumbing in the restrooms with plastic. The Board discussed the need for a new floor. Lamar has contacted K & M for a quote. Brian Kaltreider is looking into materials to repair the roof. Laverne also stated the salt shed is in need of repairs.

Scott Zeigler was present to speak to the Board about comprehensive time as an option for overtime. The road crew would have the option of taking time off instead of getting paid for overtime. The Supervisors will consider this suggestion at a later time.

Laverne would like the Supervisors to ride the Township's road with him and look at pipes that are in need of repair throughout the Township.

Michael Mathias presented his final subdivision plan and stormwater plan to the Board. Brian made a motion to approve and sign the plan, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Brian made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 P.M.
