

February 9, 2011

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on February 9, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney John Herrold, Bill Fogle, Mike Bittner, Bob & Robert Rebert and Carisa Kreichauf.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Brian made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold presented Ordinance #11-1 establishes a 25 mph speed limit on Codorus Lane and Hardwood Terrace. Brian made a motion to adopt ordinance 11-1, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Ordinance #11-2 was presented. This ordinance prohibits trucks with a gross weight in excess of 10,000 pounds on Shaffers Church Road between 516 & 616. School buses, emergency vehicles and trucks making local deliveries or pickups shall be exempt. Bob Rebert expressed his concerns with this ordinance. Bob Gladfelter made a motion to adopt Ordinance #11-2, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Mike Bittner presented his permit for a fireworks display on July 2, 2011. Brian made a motion to sign the permit, seconded by Bob. The motion carried.

The Board discussed the problem of cars parking on the road during snowstorms. Township Ordinance 99-2 does not allow cars to be parked on the roads. The road crew could put notes on the cars that are parking on the road stating that the people are in violation of this ordinance. Attorney Herrold will check with some other Townships to see how they handle this problem.

The Township has been receiving complaints of Francis Langrill's horses running loose. Bill said he needs proof that the horses are coming from her property before he can go to the magistrate.

Lamar reported that he met with two of the Springfield Township Supervisors and C.S. Davidson concerning the Springfield Ln. bridge. The bridge needs to be replaced. The Board discussed closing the bridge. Brian is not in favor of closing the bridge. Lamar made a motion to close the bridge, seconded by Bob. Brian voted no. The motion carried. Vote 2-1.

The road maintenance agreement for Kevin Mummert's subdivision was presented to the Board. Lamar made a motion to sign the agreement, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Brian made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 10:00 P.M.
