The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on July 7, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang, Barbara Raid and Wayne Smith.

The meeting opened with the Pledge to the flag.

Lamar made a motion to accept the minutes of the previous Board of Supervisors meeting and the special meeting held on June 30, 2011. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

Barbara Raid is an Architectural Historian for Historic York. She was present to speak about the Pierceville Run vicinity which is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places. The nomination will be submitted to the state in February.

Wayne Smith was here to inquire about the Zoning Officer position. Wayne is the Zoning Officer for several Township's and Boroughs. The Board is not ready to make decision yet.
