The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on July 13, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Robert Walsh, Peter Schilling, Jeff Shue and Attorney John Herrold.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Brian made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Robert Walsh presented the land development for Friendship School. Lamar made a motion to approve the plan, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold presented zoning ordinance #11-4 for adoption. Brian made a motion to adopt ordinance #11-4, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Brian presented pictures and paperwork from Wayne McSherry on the Steger case. The papers will be kept on file until the lawsuit between Zartman and Steger is settled.

Jeff Shue spoke about the walking trail at the Codorus Estates development. Several home owners have complained about the gravel path. Jeff will contact Jim Holley's office to discuss the plan.

Jeff is working on the Integrated Water Resource Plan ordinance. This is the new 167 plan that will cover the entire county.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
