

November 14, 2012

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on November 14, 2012 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney John Herrold, Jeff Shue, Peter Schilling, Ed Ward, Steve Forbes and Donald Bubb.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Lamar made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold opened and read the bids for the Waste Collection contract. Only one bid was received from Penn Waste. The basic proposal is for \$22.45 per month. The tag-a-bag program is \$4.25 per bag with a required minimal purchase of 24 bags per year. Brian made a motion to award the contract to Penn Waste. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Steve Forbes and Donald Bubb were present to discuss the stormwater issue on Pierceville Road. Steve reported that the lane washed out on October 19th but, no one has been down to the property. Attorney Herrold suggested that Steve and Donald hire a private Attorney to sue for damages. Peter Schilling has sent a violation notice to Lynne Friedman. Peter will see if he can file criminal charges against the stormwater ordinance.

Attorney Herrold presented ordinance 12-2 amending the Township zoning ordinance. Bob made a motion to adopt ordinance 12-2. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The Board discussed updating the zoning ordinance. The Board would like to have the zoning ordinance reviewed and updated. Bob made a motion to hire C.S. Davidson to review and update the zoning ordinance. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Peter Schilling gave a report on violations that is working on.

The Board discussed hiring Stephen Nafe to help plow snow on a as needed basis. Bob made a motion to pay Stephen \$20.20 per hour, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 11:00
