

May 9, 2012

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on May 9, 2012 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney Herrold, Doug Crawford, Robert, Tumberlinson and Dale Richardson.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Dale Richardson came representing the Glen Rock Fire Company and Ambulance. He needed a paper signed to allow the rescue truck to respond to ambulance calls. Bob made a motion to sign the change, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Dale also spoke to the board about the closing of the Springfield Road Bridge. He explained that it adds 2 miles onto trips for his family. Dale and his wife with the Glen Rock ambulance and this adds an extra 2-3 minutes to their time. The board explained that the repairs that are needed to the bridge are too costly.

Attorney Herrold presented Ordinance 12-2 amending several sections of the zoning ordinance. Brian made a motion to adopt the ordinance, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Robert Tumberlinson was present to check on the progress of the church lights. April spoke to Sid Krebs and was told the light bulbs have not delivered yet.

Doug Crawford presented the sewage planning module for Bob Gladfelter's 2 lot subdivision plan. Lamar made a motion to sign the module, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 2-0. Bob abstained from voting.

Brian talked to Peter Schilling about filing charges against Christopher Mettee every day. Peter will send 1 weeks violations to magistrate every week starting on May 11, 2012.

Attorney Herrold will work on filing a complaint with the magistrate against Ralph and Stephanie Duncan.

The Board would like to hire Glenn Bortner as a part time seasonal employee at a rate of \$13.50 per hour. Lamar made a motion to hire Glenn, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Kay Hentzel would like to sell fireworks during the week of July 4th at the Ratters store in Codorus Township. The Township will not issue a permit for this but with Rutters permission she can sell the fireworks there.

Bob reported that the roller is need of a new battery and break repair. The Board will speak to Laverne.

The Board would like for the roadcrew to tar & chip the large parking lot at the park.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 P.M.
