The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on December 12, 2012 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang, Attorney John Herrold, Jeff Shue, Donald Bubb and Steve Forbes.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Steve Forbes reported that he has his E & S plan completed. The stormwater issue at the Friedman property on Pierceville Road was discussed. Ms. Friedman's engineer has submitted a plan to the York County Conservation District. Jeff Shue will get a copy of the plan and review it for the Township. Attorney Herrold will work on a draft for an enforcement notice for Pete Schilling to send to Ms. Friedman.

Jeff Shue reported that the surveyors are working on the survey for the Springfield bridge abandonment.

Jeff will be meeting Karen Ward from the York County Conservation District at the Ferguson property on Brush Valley Road on Thursday morning to look at the driveway issue.

Laverne Wolfgang gave the Roadmaster report. The dirt road grant to Johnson Road is complete and has been turned over to Gary Peacock.

Laverne reported that there is still a problem at Janet Dicke's property on Valley View Road. Janet has placed hay bales on her property and the water is running into the road. Lamar will go out with Laverne and look at this problem.

The Junkyard License for Clair Amspacher was presented. Bob made a motion to issue a junkyard license to Clair Amspacher for the year 2013. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The Fireworks License for Fireworks Extravagancy was presented. Brian made a motion to issue the License. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The proposed budget was reviewed and updated. Lamar made a motion to adopt the budget as corrected. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 P.M.
