The cost is \$3,200.00. Lamar has contacted Security fence for an estimate for an outfield fence for the big ball field. The cost will be approximately \$8,550.00. Brian made a motion to have the fence put up and purchase the conditioning machine. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
