The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on September 6, 2012 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: Laverne Wolfgang and April Rehbein.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Brian made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Laverne gave the roadmaster report. Residents on Johnson Road have complained about people speeding and tearing up the road. The board will not put up speed limit signs on a dirt road. Laverne is waiting for parts for the roller. The road crew is working on Johnson Road and Young Road.

Lamar spoke to Mr. Hopkins a resident of Springfield Township. He owns the property at the Springfield Road Bridge. He said he doesn't mind the bridge closing but, wanted to know if the holes near the bridge can be filled in with dirt. Laverne will take dirt out and fill in.

Lamar received a letter from the Rail Trail Authority asking for donations. The Board decided not to budget any funds at this time.

Lamar reported that there is still one horse and the fence is still up at Annette Grzymala's property. The Board would like Pete Schilling to send an enforcement notice. The Board also would like Pete to send enforcement notices to the Brodbeck's Creamery. The Board has been told that someone is living there. Also it looks like someone is living in a camper at 4544 Shaffers Church Rd.

Lamar reported that Brian Miller fertilized the fields at the park. The outfield fence is complete at the large baseball field. Lamar has been in contact with a boy scout that may be able to build a bridge from the parking lot to the small baseball field. The Mason Dixon Ruffnecks have someone that will be building dugouts for both fields.

The Board discussed looking for someone that could help with snowplowing as needed this winter.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 P.M.
