The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on April 11, 2012 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein and Attorney John Herrold.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Brian made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold received a letter from Cary Rothman's Attorney regarding Christopher Mettee's property. Brian talked to Peter Schilling and he plans on filing charges at the Magistrate next week. The Board would like Peter to ask the Magistrate if he could file charges everyday.

Lamar reported that he spoke to Annette Grzymala concerning the horses on her property. Peter Schilling sent a letter that the property is less than 1.5 acres so the horses are not allowed. Lamar told her she will need to show proof that her property is 1.5 acres or larger by June 1, 2012.

Attorney Herrold reported he has not had a response from Ralph & Stephanie Duncan regarding the payment owed for the road closure. The Board would like Attorney Herrold to file charges with the Magistrate.

A letter was received from the York County School District. The district would like permission to have the Southern Regional Police patrol Route 216 between the school safety speed signs at Friendship Elementary School. The School District will assume all costs for this service. Lamar made a motion to grant permission, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The Recreation Board would like to have a plaque made to place at Bailey Field stating the land was donated to the Township by James & Sandra Bailey. The Supervisors agreed.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:50 P.M.
