

September 5, 2013

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on September 5, 2013 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Robert Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Aldo Della Coletta and Marjorie Shaxted.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Lamar made a motion to approve the amended minutes from the July 10 2013 meeting, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bob made a motion to approve the minute minutes from August 14, 2013 meeting. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar reported that he spoke to Brian Brown of Mummert Road. Brian lives on the dirt part of Mummert Road and would like to purchase millings to put on the road. Brian would pay for the millings if the Township road crew could provide the labor for spreading and rolling the millings. This would improve road and make it easier to plow. The Board is willing to provide the labor if Brian wants to pay for the material.

Aldo Della Coletta and Marjorie Shaxted were present to discuss their application for a building permit. They were told they need to clean up the junk on their property. Mr. Della Coletta applied for a building permit was turned down since the site is in a flood zone. Mr. Della Coletta was told to speak to DEP to see if any building would be allowed and how to proceed. The Board will have Peter Schilling visit the property to see how much junk has been cleaned up.

The recreation fees were discussed by the Board. Bob made a motion to raise the recreation fees to \$2,100.00. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0. The Board will have Attorney Herrold draw up an ordinance.

April presented a quote from Henry's lock service for a door buzzer system for \$1,094.00. Lamar made a motion to accept the quote and have the system installed. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar reported that 6 picnic tables were built by a Boy Scout for an Eagle Scout project.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:10 P.M.
