

November 7, 2013

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on November 7, 2013 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang, Leslie Humphrey, Kathy Warner and Steve and Carolyn Bupp.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Under public comments Carolyn Bupp had questions about the recreation fee. She was told that the recreation fee is a fee that is imposed on each lot of a subdivision. Carolyn also wanted to know what the rake conditioner is used for. Lamar told her it is used at the park on the ball fields.

Leslie Humphrey and Kathy Warner live 2 houses down from Rogers Pit Beef. They are concerned about a big sign that is blocking their site distance when they are pulling out of their driveway onto S.R. 216. They have asked the owner to move the sign back from the road but, he refuses to move it. Lamar will check out the problem.

Laverne gave the Roadmaster report. The men have been going over the scag mower. They will replace the belts and purchase a new battery. Laverne presented some prices for loaders and backhoes for the board to review.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Tom Moore's resignation was presented to the board. Tom will be resigning from the Planning Commission following the December meeting. Bob made a motion to accept Tom's resignation, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Tom Insley's resignation was presented to the board. Tom will be resigning from the Jefferson Codorus Joint Sewer Authority in December. Lamar made a motion to accept Tom's resignation. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar would like for the secretary to get an update from Peter Schilling on the following: Steve Gantz has not removed mobile home from his property, status of complaint for William Graf, and Craig Coleman built porch without a permit.

The Board would like an update on Kevin Ferguson from Karen Ward.

Lamar reported that the bridge will be set on Sunny Slope Road on November 21st or November 22nd. Lamar will meet with people that will be affected by the power being turned off. The power will be off for 6-8 hours.

There is a pipe that needs replaced on Cherry Run Road. Laverne was told to order the pipe.

A quote was received from John H. Myers and Home Depot for materials for the park pavilion. Home Depot quoted \$8,298.26, John H. Myers quoted \$7,807.39. Bob made a motion to order the materials from John H. Myers, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar reported that Lee Irwin has the permits to start the work on the creek and will be tearing out the Springfield Road Bridge.

The meeting adjourned at 8:25.
