The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on October 3, 2013 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Kaltreider and Bob Gladfelter. Others present were: April Rehbein and Laverne Wolfgang.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Lamar made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Laverne Wolfgang gave the roadmaster report. The road crew installed a pipe at 3134 Brush Valley Road. Laverne was informed by Gary Peacock that the Township was granted a dirt and gravel road grant for Sunny Slope Road. Since Laverne doesn't think they can get the work done this year an extension was granted to November 2014. Laverne would like to purchase a 14" demo saw from Tri Boro construction at a cost of \$1306.43. Bob made a motion to purchase the saw, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar made a motion to set Trick or Treat night for October 31, 2013 from 6:00 P.M. – 8:00 P.M. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar and Laverne met with Preston Beall at his property on Pentland Road following up on a complaint that was filed with the York County Conservation District. They didn't see any problems with stormwater runoff at this property.

Lamar and Laverne also visited Aldo Dellacoleta and Marjorie Shaxted property. There is still a lot of junk on the property. It was decided to let Peter Schilling continue with the magistrate.

Lamar reported that the walking paths at the park are done. The millings are in place. Lamar will get a quote from Coleman to pave the path around the soccer fields. The reseeding has been completed at the park.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 P.M.
