The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on November 13, 2013 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney Scott Lineberry, Carolyn & Steve Bupp and Mr. & Mrs. Webb.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Brian made a motion to approve the minutes as corrected. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Mr. & Mrs. Webb were present to inform the board that will be purchasing Edwin Luckes junkyard. They plan on cleaning up the place and bringing in some newer inventory. The Board informed them that they will have to pay a fee of \$75.00 to have the license transferred to their name and that there is an annual fee of \$100.00 to keep the license active.

Carolyn Bupp received the home occupation permit from Peter Schilling and stated that the name on the permit should read Steven Bupp Masonry Inc. April will contact Peter to make this change.

The Board spoke to Scott about the issue of cars parking on the road during snow and ice events in the Codorus Estates Development. Scott will look into this issue and see what can be done.

The Board discussed the issue with George Williams's property. George did a subdivision without a plan. The Board will send George a letter stating that a subdivision plan will be needed and that there is only 1 building right remaining. Bob made a motion to have Attorney Malone issue the letter, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

A few minor changes were made to the Township Emergency Management plan such as change of phone numbers. Bob made a motion to revise the plan, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:05 P.M.
