The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on February 13, 2013 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Kaltreider, and Bob Gladfelter. Others present were: April Rehbein and Attorney Herrold.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Brian made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold reported that a complaint was filed against Lynne Friedman of Pierceville Road because she is in violation of the Township Ordinance.

The Board asked Attorney Herrold if anything can be done about cars parking on the roads in Codorus Estates during snow and ice events. Signs could be posted that cars parked on the road during snow or ice events that require cindering will be towed. However, a traffic study would be needed.

Lamar questioned if the Board can send letters out to residents that are in violation of the ordinance before getting the Zoning Officer involved. Attorney Herrold said that a letter could be sent asking the resident to comply with an ordinance.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:50 P.M.
