

May 8, 2013

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on May 8, 2013 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney John Herrold, Roland and Patricia Cumor and Jeff Brown.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Jeff Brown of Keller Brown Insurance and a representative from H.A. Thompson were present to discuss PIRMA Insurance. They explained in detail how the insurance works. The Board decided not to make a decision at this time.

Roland Cumor was before the board to discuss a complaint he filed with the Township on December 21, 2012. Mr. Cumor stated there are still 6 cars parking on the Davis property and there isn't sufficient room for parking. He stated that 2 families are living in the big house and 1 family is living in the small house. Mr. Cumor would like to know what the Township intends to do about these issues. Brian Kaltreider will get in touch with Peter Schilling to discuss the issues.

Brian Kaltreider gave an update on some zoning problems. Brian reported that Steve Bupp obtained a permit for a pavilion in 2008 but never had a final inspection done. Steve also added four walls to the pavilion without a building permit. Brian also reported that Christopher Rutters on Fiscal Road is boarding 15 horses and providing riding lessons. The Rutters do not have a permit for boarding.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 10:15 P.M.
