

September 11, 2013

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on September 11, 2013 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Kaltreider and Bob Gladfelter. Others present were: April Rehbie, Attorney Herrold, David Tuten, William Curry and Judy Cockey.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Judy Cockey has an apartment house at the corner of Steltz Road and Middletown Road. Penndot repaved the road and filled in the ditch along the road. Since the paving was done they are getting water in the basement apartment. Penndot stated that it is a problem that the Township will need to deal with. Brian has called Penndot and is waiting for a return phone call.

Bill Curry reported that Preston Beall purchased the property next to him and made some modifications to a ditch on the property that takes the water down to the road. Now hard rains run across their right-of-way. Karen Ward of the Conservation District has been to the property and will send a report to the Township.

David Tuten was present representing the Glen Rock Library. He gave a yearly report on the Library.

Bob Gladfelter made a motion to amend resolution # 13-1 to include fee schedule for open records .25 per page produced pursuant to open records request. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold reported that there was a mistake in the name on the cable franchise ordinance and agreement. A new ordinance will need to be passed. Attorney Herrold has advertised this for October 9, 2013.

The ordinance for the abandonment of West Springfield Road has also been advertised for October 9, 2013.

Attorney Herrold will draft an ordinance to raise the recreation fees to \$2,100 and send to the Codorus Township Planning Commission and the York County Planning Commission for comments.

The zoning hearing application for Christopher & Toma Rutters was discussed. One Supervisor will appear at the hearing to request that reasonable conditions be applied if the application is accepted.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 10:10 P.M.
