The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on January 8, 2013 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Steve & Carolyn Bupp, Attorney Herrold, Robert Smith & Jim Eckman.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Robert Smith & Jim Eckman were before the board to talk about the dog tethering ordinance. The SPCA has sent a copy of a sample ordinance. Jim & Robert would like for the Supervisors to look into adopting this ordinance. Attorney Herrold will review the ordinance.

Carolyn Bupp said she would like the Township to send out a newsletter. The newsletter could include the opening for tax collector and planning commission member.

Lisa Mansperger's resignation was presented to the Board. Lisa is no longer living in Codorus Township so she can no longer hold the position of tax collector.

Bob made a motion to appoint Lisa Lloyd as tax collector. Lisa will hold the position until January 2016. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Carolyn Bupp had questions about her Cross Creek Farm sign that was up at both ends of Krebs Road. She was told by Bill Fogle that there was no such thing as a sign permit. However Carolyn went through the permits that were issued and noticed that sign permits have been issued to other people. The Board gave permission to Carolyn and Steve to place their signs back up at the intersection of Krebs Road and S.R. 516 and the intersection of Krebs Road and S.R. 616.

Shannon Cherry & Mary Warner would like to take an online course through PSATS for Township Auditors. The cost is \$50.00 per person. Lamar made a motion to pay for the Auditors training, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
