

May 14, 2014

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on May 14, 2014 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney Herrold, Carolyn & Steve Bupp, Alan Case & Kate Klunk.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Lamar made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Bob seconded the motion. Carolyn Bupp had questions about paragraph six. She said she didn't ask if Spoutwood Farm was in compliance, that Laverne Wolfgang made the comment.

The stone bids were opened and read as follows:

York Building bid:

100 tons Rock Lining R4 @ \$14.50 per ton
4,500 tons DSA Stone @ \$10.70 per ton

Brian made a motion to award the bid for various stones excluding the DSA to York Building. Since the Board has not been satisfied with the quality of DSA from York Building & Kinsley Materials the DSA bid will be awarded to Vulcan Materials. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bids for Option # 1 for the placing of Superpave material on Shaffers Church Rd. & Johnson Road were opened and read as follows:

Stewart & Tate bid:

Superpave 25MM @ \$5.49 per ton
Superpave 9.5 MM @ \$7.98 per ton
Bituminous Asphalt Curbing @ \$35.35 per ton

Long's Asphalt bid:

Superpave 25MM @ \$8.65 per ton
Superpave 9.5 MM @ \$8.10 per ton
Bituminous Asphalt Curbing @ \$10.00 per ton

Kinsley Construction bid:

Superpave 25MM @ \$4.88 per ton
Superpave 9.5 MM @ \$6.86 per ton
Bituminous Asphalt Curbing @ \$9.79 per ton

Bob made a motion to award the bid to Kinsley Construction, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bob made a motion to reject all bids for Option # 2 placing of Superpave material on Shaffers Church Rd. & Johnson Road due to a miscalculation of the tonnage. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bids for furnishing Superpave material were opened and read as follows:

York Materials Group bid:

Superpave 19 MM @ \$58.05 per ton
Superpave 25 MM @ \$54.75 per ton
Superpave 9.5 MM @ \$64.10 per ton

Brian made a motion to award the bid to York Materials Group, Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bids for 40,000 gallons of CRS-2 were opened and read as follows:

Stewart & Tate bid \$2.10 per gallon

Hammaker East bid \$2.028 per gallon

Midland Asphalt Materials bid \$ 2.11 per gallon.

Lamar made a motion to award the bid to Hammaker East. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Carolyn Bupp would like to the Supervisor's to consider adopting an agritainment ordinance.

Attorney Herrold presented a change for the proposed sign ordinance. The change would make advertising signs at the Township recreation park exempt from the ordinance. The Board will present the change to the Township Planning Commission for review.

Lamar reported that Tony LoPiccolo will be installing a gate on his property to prevent people from driving up to the abandoned Springfield Road Bridge. He will contact Penndot to see how close to the road the gate can be.

The quotes for Liquid Calcium Chloride were presented to the Board as follows:

Recon quoted \$1.19 per gallon

Environmental Energy Solutions quoted \$1.37 per gallon

Calcium Chloride Sales, Inc. quoted \$1.12 per gallon

Lamar made a motion to accept the quote of Calcium Chloride Sale, Inc. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:15 P.M.
