The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on December 10, 2014 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie VanScoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Dave Rehbein, Bambi Hartlaub, Jim Morris, John & Scarlet Ampsacher, Vivian Vincent Jim Dunlap Carolyn & Steve Bupp and Attorney Herrold.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Lamar made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Under public comments Carolyn Bupp commented that the newsletter did not mention to proposed special events ordinance or that the Board had a new Supervisor.

Attorney Herrold presented the special events ordinance. The ordinance was discussed. The comments have not been received by York County Planning Commission. Bob made a motion to table the ordinance until the comments are received. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Jim Dunlap presented a plan to add lights on the steeple of St. Jacobs Lutheran Church. It was suggested that the church install lights that could be dimmed if needed.

Bambi Hartlaub was present to discuss the tax collector position. She has been highly interested in the position. She will let the Board know in a few days if she is interested in the position for 2015.

Lisa Lloyd would like to deputize the York County Treasurer to finish out collecting the taxes for 2014. Bob made a motion to sign the paperwork. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Bob had prices from Mar Bar & Henise for tires for the loader. Mar Bar has a 16 ply tire for \$3,545 and Henise has a 12 ply tire for \$3,017. The Board decided to purchase the tires from Mar Bar.

The final budget for 2015 was presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to adopt the budget, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 10:10 P.M.
