

April 3, 2014

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on April 3, 2014 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Laverne Wolfgang, Brian Baer, Crystal Hoover, Michelle Jones, Carolyn & Steve Bupp.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Under public comment Crystal Hoover and Michelle Jones presented pictures of a property on Seven Valleys Road showing piles of junk on the neighbor's property. The Board will forward the pictures to Peter Schilling and have him send out a citation letter.

April received a letter from the Home Owners Association at Codorus Estates requesting 3 way stop signs in the development. The residents said there is a problem with speeding in the development. Lamar will drive out and take a look at the intersections.

A letter was received from Stock and Leader with an update on Aldo DellaColetta's property clean up.

The Board discussed paving projects for the summer. They would like to pave a portion of Cherry Run Road from Rohrbaugh Rd. to S.R. 616, Shaffers Church Rd. from Buffalo Valley to S.R. 516 and Johnson Road.

Bob reported that the DSA will be placed on a portion of Sunny Slope Road and he plans on applying for a grant for the rest of the road this spring.

Lamar presented pictures of the cars at William Graff's property on Strickhouser Road. Lamar will go out again next week to see if there are any changes.

Bob presented a quote from O2 Digital Creative Agency to the Board for a new Township website. The cost of the new website would be \$3,943.40. Lamar made a motion to accept the quote, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar said that a plan needs to be in place for traffic signs by June 13, 2014. Someone will need to travel all the Township roads and record any signs that need to be replaced.

Carolyn Bupp questioned the Board about advertising signs at the Township Park. Carolyn feels if the Township sells advertising signs they would be violating the sign ordinance. The Board will discuss this Attorney Herrold at the next meeting.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45 P.M.
