

July 9, 2014

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on July 9, 2014 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: April Rehbein, Dave Rehbein, Randy Sterner, Steve Harner, and Jeff Nelson.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

No meeting was held on July 3, 2014 due to lack of a quorum.

Brian made a motion to approve the minutes of June 11, 2014 meeting as presented. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

Steve Harner is a resident of Johnson Road. He would like to request that a speed limit be placed on Johnson Road after it has been paving. The Supervisors will contact York County Planning to have a traffic study done.

Jeff Nelson is State Farm Insurance agent. He is working for William Davis to try and obtain a grant from FEMA to buy Mr. Davis' property that is getting flooded. Jeff is requesting that the Township adopt the York County Flood Mitigation plan. Jeff is also requesting that the Township write a letter that Jeff can file for the grant on the Township's behalf. There is reimbursement available for this which Jeff would like to receive. Attorney Herrold will need to investigate this to see if the Township can do this. Also the Township will need to see the York County Flood Mitigation plan before adopting a resolution.

The public comment resolution # 2014-02 was presented to the Board. Brian made a motion to adopt the resolution, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

Rob Wood has contacted Lamar about holding more activities on his property. Attorney Herrold will compose a letter stating that Spoutwood is only approved for the Fairy Festival and the Mother Earth Festival. If they would like to hold other events they will need to comply with the Township ordinance.

Dave Rehbein will be mowing the township roads part time. Lamar made a motion to pay Dave \$15.00 per hour for mowing. There are no additional benefits. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 P.M.
