

February 12, 2014

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on February 12, 2014. Board member present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Brian Kaltreider and Bob Gladfelter. Others present were: April Rehbein, Troy Snyder, Aldo Dellacoletta and Attorney John Herrold.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Lamar made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Troy Snyder, Fire Chief of the Jefferson Fire Company was present with the annual report. Troy also discussed the water assurance study.

Aldo Dellacoletta & Marjorie Shaxted were present to discuss their proposed pole building. Also had his property surveyed and he has a letter from the surveyor stating that the proposed building location is not in the flood zone. Lamar told Aldo he will need to find out what the right-of-way is from the railroad before he can move forward with his building permit application.

The tethering ordinance sent from the SPCA was discussed. Attorney Herrold explained there is really no need for the ordinance since this would be covered under the cruelty to animal statute.

Dennis Coster, owner of Fireworks Extravaganza would like to demo his products to potential buyers at his Greenmount Church property sometime in April or May. He would also like to have a show on July 4th at this property. The Board would allow the July 4th show, however they would not allow the demo in the spring.

Lisa Lloyd would like to take a course for new tax collectors. The cost is \$250.00. Lamar made a motion to pay for this course, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar made a motion to appoint Brenda Miller to the Planning Commission, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The Board discussed hiring Bob Gladfelter as a full time road worker. Brian made a motion to hire Bob as a full time road worker starting on April 1, 2014 with a 60 day probation period, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 2-0. Bob abstained from voting.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 9:40 P.M.
