

March 6, 2014

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on March 6, 2014 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Brian Kaltreider. Others present were: Lieutenant Fred Ness, April Rehbein, and Carolyn & Steve Bupp.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lieutenant Fred Ness of the PA State Police was present to give the annual report. Lieutenant Ness said if the Township receives complaints for speeding for certain areas to let him know and he will set up radar.

Carolyn Bupp presented a request to amend the January 8, 2014 minutes. She said the statement "She was told by Bill Fogle that there was no such thing as a sign permit" is incorrect. Lamar said he doesn't want to amend the minutes.

Three quotes were received for two portable toilets for the Township park as follows:

Knappers quoted- \$164.00 per month

Walters quoted \$224.00 per month

Associated Products quoted \$240.00 per month

Bob made a motion to award the job to Knappers. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Dawn Stockbridge contacted the Township office to request a safety study at the Sticks cross road. The Township will contact Penndot to have the study conducted.

Lamar made a motion to recommend that the Township Auditors set the pay for Bob Gladfelter at \$18.73 per hour, and to allow vacation, sick, funeral pay and jury duty pay as set forth for other full time employees. Also allow participation in the Township pension plan and health insurance plan. Brian seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 2-0. Bob abstained from the vote.

Changes have been made to the FEMA flood maps. The Township needs to contact residents whose properties are now shown in the flood plain.

The pipe on Cherry Run Road near S.R. 616 has collapsed. Bob has applied for an emergency permit to replace the pipe.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Brian. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Brian brought up Carolyn Bupp's request to amend the January 8, 2014 minutes. After further discussion the Board did believe that the minutes were incorrect. The sentence that "She was told by Bill Fogle that there was no such thing as sign permit" should be removed.

The meeting adjourned at 8:50 P.M.
