The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on December 9, 2015 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney Herrold, John Amspacher, Steve Bupp and Brian Kaltreider.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

Under Public Comments Brian Kaltreider asked if the Board had any feeling on the review request that was sent to the Attorney General by Hillandale Gettysburg. Attorney Herrold stated that at this point the Township just has to wait the 120 day for the review to be completed before any action is taken.

Attorney Herrold presented the new flood plain ordinance. Bob made a motion to adopt Ordinance # 15-07, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

A traffic study has been conducted by York County Planning Commission for weight limit and speed limit on Snyder Mill Rd. Attorney Herrold will draw up the ordinances.

Bob made a motion to approve the budget for 2016. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

A waiver of the 100 ft. minimum well to drain field was presented for Darlene Myers. The Board was not willing to sign the waiver. The proposed septic system would only be 48 ft. from the well. The property consists of 15 acres. The Board feels there should be another alternative.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 P.M.
