

June 10, 2015

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on June 10, 2015 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie VanScoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Attorney John Herrold, Brian Kaltreider, Robert & Linda Smith, Dennis & Betty Wagner, Tom & Kay Hensel and Steve & Carolyn Bupp.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Carolyn Bupp stated that the minutes from May 13, 2015 said the Board went into executive session but did not state the topic of the executive session. Also the Board resumed the meeting after the executive session and they were not told to come back in the building.

Kay Hensel would like to set up a tent and sell and sell fireworks that are legal to sell to PA residents. She was told this is not allowed in the AG zone but would be permitted in the commercial zone. She should also contact Pete Schilling to see if a permit is needed.

Dennis Wagner would like to get an AG permit for fireworks. Birds are eating his cherries and he would like to purchase bottle rockets and penny stick firecrackers. He needs a permit that allows him to purchase these fireworks. Bob made a motion to issue a permit to Dennis Wagner to purchase bottle rockets and penny stick firecrackers to be used solely for AG purposes. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Carolyn had questions about the proposed ordinance that was sent to York County Planning Commission. She asked if the Township could only adopt portions of the ordinance or would they have to adopt the entire ordinance. Attorney Herrold said if substantial changes were made to the ordinance it would have to go back to York County Planning. Carolyn said the language in this ordinance is stopping family farms from doing things such as corn mazes without being a farm market or without charging any fees.

Brian Kaltreider presented a health ordinance from Lehigh Township. The Board will look over this ordinance and Brian will present it to the Planning Commission at the June meeting.

Bob Gladfelter has written a letter of support to Glen Rock Borough for their DCED grant application. Bob made a motion to sign the letter, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45 P.M.
