

January 14, 2015

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on January 14, 2015 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie VanScoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Brian Baer, Steve Forbes and Carolyn & Steve Bupp.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag. Lamar made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Under public comment Steve Bupp commented that he feels the meeting minutes are too vague and should be more detailed.

Carolyn Bupp has some concerns about the proposed Special Events Ordinance. She is concerned with the wording other parties and gatherings. Carolyn was told that the ordinance has been sent back to the Township Planning Commission. It would be best for her to take her concerns to the Planning Commission meeting.

Attorney Herrold presented Resolution 2015-02 adding lands owned by Carl & Diana Close, Robert & Linda Morris, Robert & Carla Rebert and Roger & Nancy Sterner to the Agricultural Security Area. Charlie made a motion to pass resolution 2015-02, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

An Agreement between the York County Treasurer's Office and Codorus Township was presented to the Board. This agreement allows the York County Treasurer's Office to collect the real estate taxes for Codorus Township from January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015. Lamar made a motion to sign the agreement, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The uncollected real estate taxes for 2014 were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to exonerate Lisa Lloyd (York County Treasurer) from the uncollected taxes. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar reported that the Recreation Board met on Tuesday. A group is going to be installing disc golf at the Township Park. Handicap parking signs needed to be ordered.

Attorney Herrold reported that since the new gun law took effect the park rules ordinance will need to be repealed to delete the section that doesn't allow fire arms at the park. This section should also be removed from the signs at the park.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8: 50 P.M.
