

April 2, 2015

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on April 2, 2015 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie VanScoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Terry White, Mick Wickham, Carolyn & Steve Bupp.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Terry White moved on to Zeigler Rd. approximately 1 year ago. The house he purchased was wired for Verizon DSL. The previous owner had the Verizon service. However, Verizon is refusing to give Mr. White the service. He has made many calls to Verizon but still has not gotten any satisfaction. He came to the Township to see if there is anything the Supervisors can do to help. He was told there really isn't anything the Township can do.

Mick Wickham was here representing a group of Snyder Mill Road citizens. He would like to request that the Township have a traffic study done on Snyder Mill Road and the bridge that is on the road. He would like the study to be done for speed limit and weight restrictions. He was told the Board will consider having a study done by York County Planning Commission. This bridge is not part of the County Bridge inspection program. The county only inspects bridges that have at least a 20' span. Usually our road crew inspects the smaller bridges and does repairs as needed.

The bids were opened for excavating and installing the two play grounds at the Municipal Park on March 27th. Lamar made a motion to award the base bid to Doug Lamb in the amount of \$98,696.00. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0. The Board will have Attorney Herrold review the bid before signing the contract.

A letter from the Township Auditors was presented to the Board. The Township audit for 2014 is complete. Bob made a motion to accept the letter. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar presented the quote for the rubber mats needed for the disc golf course. Eighteen 3x8 mats are needed at a cost of \$1.00 per sq ft. Bob made a motion to purchase the mats, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar presented the quote for the disc golf baskets. Nineteen baskets are needed. The total cost is \$6,625.00. Lamar made a motion to purchase the baskets. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar met with the Audubon Society regarding bluebird houses. There is grant money available to build the boxes. The Township will need to purchase the post. The boxes will be built using cedar.

Bob gave the Roadmaster report. Bids will be going out in May for stones, tar & chip and joint sealing. Bob started the grant paper work for Ridge Road. Bob would like to have an asphalt

zipper machine brought in for a demonstration. This machine grinds down approx. 12" then tar & chip can be placed on top. We have at least 25 miles of road that need to be done.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:25 P.M.
