The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on March 11, 2015 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie VanScoyoc. Others present were: Attorney John Herrold, April Rehbein, Scott Osman, Lee Hoffeins, Lanis Saurausaitis, Steve & Carolyn Bupp, Bobbi Utz and Sergeant Dan Devilbliss.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Lamar seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Under public comments Lee Hoffeins, the Glen Rock, Borough tax collector said he checked with the Southern York County School district and they do not have the authority to appoint a tax collector.

Scott Osman stated that in all fairness to the candidates running for tax collector if the Board wants to appoint someone they should consider someone that is not a candidate. Scott feels appointing York County to collect the taxes saves the Township money.

Sergeant Dan Devilbliss from PA State Police was present to give a report on crime in Codorus Township. He reported that the Township is quiet with very little crime. If the Township has any complaints or concerns they can email him or Lieutenant Baker.

Lanis Saurausaitis & Bobbi Utz were present from the Lineboro Volunteer Fire Company. Lanis reported that the EMT's no longer need to hold dual certifications to work in PA & MD. He reported that Lineboro has paid paramedics & EMT's on duty 24 -7.

The advertising banners for the park were discussed. Attorney Herrold draft an agreement for people that wish to purchase a sign.

The Board went into executive session.

The executive session adjourned at 9:30 P.M.

Three quotes were presented to the Board for portable toilets for the park as follows:

Knappers quoted \$92.00 per toilet per month

Associated Products Services quoted \$120.00 per toilet per month

Walters quoted \$116.00 per toilet per month

Charlie made a motion to accept the quote of Knappers. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The sewage planning module for William McGrew was presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to sign the module, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Baseball dugouts for the park baseball fields were discussed. Lamar made a motion to have Charlie VanScoyoc build the dugouts. Bob seconded the motion. Charlie abstained from voting. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 10:00 P.M.
