The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on June 13, 2018 at 7:30 PM. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April Rehbein, Kim & Joe Roberts, Steve & Carolyn Bupp, Brian Baer, Russell Walker & Attorney John Herrold.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Lamar Glatfelter made an announcement that an executive session was held to discuss an issue with a property on Greenmount Church Rd.

The minutes were approved as presented.

April Rehbein & Carolyn Bupp are recording the meeting.

The bids were opened for the 1995 Ford Dump Truck as follows:

Preston Beal bid \$3,501.00

Rich Reinholt bid \$3,200.00

Bidder on Municibid, TAL Services bid \$10,100

Bob made a motion to award the bid to the high bidder TAL Services. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Russell Walker applied for a building permit for a pole building. Eric from South Penn Code emailed Russell and said the building could not be in the front yard area. The Supervisors explained that the Township zoning ordinance doesn't allow accessory buildings in front of the house. Mr. Walker can apply for a variance through the Zoning Hearing Board.

Attorney Herrold reported that he has sent a letter to Hammaker East regarding the Supervisors not being happy with the quality of their work. If the work is not acceptable this year the Supervisors will no longer accept their bid.

Bob reported that Kinsley Construction has sent a bill for wait time for the Roser Road project. Bob will forward the bill to Vulcan Material.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
