The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

Under public comment Steve Bupp presented a picture of wire and fence post which he said were in his bean field. These items belong to his neighbor Mr. Fisher. The Township will contact Eric Swiger about the fencing materials. Steve also commented that every time it rains milk jugs float down the stream from the Fisher property.

Adam Keller of Team Ag was present requesting a 90-day extension for the Hillandale plan for the proposed poultry barn. Lamar made a motion to grant the extension. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.
