The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on October 10, 2018 at 7:30 PM. Board members present were: Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April & Dave Rehbein Attorneys John & Andrew Herrold, John Amspacher, Carolyn & Steve Bupp and Kim & Joe Roberts.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

Under public comments Steve Bupp commented that a driveway was put in on Brenneman Road that is clogging up the gutter along the road. Bob will contact Eric Swiger to look at this issue.

Attorney Herrold talked about the tax credit for Fire Fighters. The Township can credit up to 20% on municipal real estate tax and or a credit for earned income tax up to \$500.00 per year. The Supervisors are interested in looking at this a little more. Bob will contact the Fire Chief at Jefferson Volunteer Fire Company.

Attorney Herrold discussed the Coster property. The Sheriffs sale was cancelled by the Attorney for the plaintiff. He didn't see anything on the mortgage foreclosure. Charlie mentioned that we have been trying for the last six months to find out if they have the property permits to store display fireworks but, have been unable to get help from any government agency.

Charlie reported that there is a resident on Brush Valley Road that is shooting into a small backstop. The state police have been contacted and advised the Township to try sending out a letter.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.
