The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

Quotes were received for the portable toilets for the park. Knappers quoted \$100.00 per month for each unit. Associated Products quoted \$135.00 per month for each unit. The Board will continue to use Knappers.

Bob Gladfelter talked about the dump trucks. Three of the trucks are getting old and the Ford Dump Truck has an oil leak. Bob has been going over the numbers and feels it's a good time to buy a new dump truck. Bob will get quotes.

Charlie reported that another tractor trailer was at the Fireworks property today. Eric Swiger has sent a violation notice. Donna Coster is appealing Eric's notice and has applied for a Zoning Hearing.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
