The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on March 1, 2018 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie VanScoyoc. Others present were: April & Dave Rehbein, John Amspacher, Steve & Carolyn Bupp, Brian Baer, Josh Gladfelter, Corporal Torkar from the PA State Police, Troy Snyder and several other Jefferson Volunteer Fire Fighters.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

April Rehbein & Carolyn Bupp are recording the meeting.

Troy Snyder gave the 2017 report for Jefferson Volunteer Fire Company. Troy reported that 29.3% of their calls were for Codorus Township. The Fire Company is holding their own financially at this time but they are going to need approximately \$500,000 in the next 2- 3 years to replace a piece of apparatus.

Corporal Torkar gave the report from the PA State Police. He reported that the police had responded to 39 responses in the Township last month. The majority of the calls in the Township were traffic stops, crashes and animals in the roadway. Only three of the calls were for thief, drug possession and a criminal mischief. Lamar brought it to Corporal Torkar attention that one of our residents had a break in and called 911 stating there was a man in house at 3:00 a.m. it took 45 minutes for a trooper to respond. Corporal Torkar said he was not familiar with the incident. He said that they have less man power at 3:00 a.m. He said he will look into this. Carolyn Bupp asked if the Amish that are being transported need to have their children restrained. Corporal Torkar said the people driving them are responsible to have them restrained.

Troy Snyder would like to ask the Township to enact a burn ordinance. Without an ordinance in place the fire company doesn't have the right to put out a fire. There is a problem with people burning at night. The Supervisors will look at other Township's ordinances.

Jesse Daughtery has sent in his resignation to resign as Township auditor. Charlie made a motion to accept his resignation, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar made a motion to appoint Kimberly Heidler to complete Jesse Daughtery's term as Auditor. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The final proposal from General Code was presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to accept and sign the proposal, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:15 P.M.
