

January 10, 2018

The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on January 10, 2018 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter, Bob Gladfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: Attorney John Herrold, Steve & Carolyn Bupp and Kim & Joe Roberts.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as corrected.

In April Rehbein's absence Bob Gladfelter and Carolyn Bupp are recording the meeting.

Under public comments Carolyn Bupp stated that she is reviewing the minutes of the December 13th meeting. The minutes state that the plan before the Board is the plan that was submitted by Stanley Bupp. Carolyn said this plan is different. It is not the plan that was submitted to York County. Bob said the Supervisors have noted her comment.

Carolyn Bupp also had a question about how the recreation fee works. Lamar explained that the fee is for a building lot. There would not be a recreation fee for their subdivision.

Steve Bupp commented that he looked at the budget. He asked about the \$45,000 from last year that the recreation fund borrowed from the General Fund. Steve was told the money borrowed from the General Fund has been paid back.

The Audit letter was presented to the Board. Charlie made a motion to sign the letter, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Attorney Herrold reported that Mr. Fisher has contacted Attorney Stacy McNeil to represent him. She will be contacting Steve & Carolyn's Attorney.

Lamar made a motion to review and advertise the ATV ordinance for adoption. Charlie seconded the motion. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

Lamar met with Spoutwood & Keith & Eric from South Penn Code Consultants. Keith had rejected Spoutwood Farms application for 2018 Fair Festival because they had not submitted all their paper from the 2017 festival. Since then Spoutwood has provided the information that Keith requested. At the meeting they discussed items they would like to be in place for the 2018 festival such as there will be no parking on Pierceville Rd. There will be signs posted that cars will be towed. There will be a construction entrance on the Forbes property where vehicles will go onto the parking lot. Keith and Lamar will make an inspection the Thursday before the Festival. This will be their last Fairy Festival. They talked about what will be going on at Spoutwood Farms. They will need to get with Keith before they do any new activities on the property. Lamar made a motion to approve the 2018 Fairy Festival application. Bob seconded the motion. The motion carried vote 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 8:00 P.M.
