The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

April Rehbein & Carolyn Bupp are recording the meeting.

Carolyn Bupp was before the Board regarding the request she made at the last meeting. Carolyn asked that the Board waive the filling and any subsequent fees associated with their variance request to the Zoning Hearing Board. Carolyn also asked if the Township is handling this as a subdivision or are they taking the properties back to how they were in 1974.

Attorney Herrold explained that the Supervisors have no authority to make any decisions on her zoning hearing application.

Carolyn asked if the application had to go the Planning Commission. She was told that once she filed the application it would be reviewed by the Planning Commission.

Matthew Hess has a property on Fiscal Road. He wanted to ask if he could live in his current house while building a new one. He was told that this would be allowed. A written agreement would be needed with a time limit as to when the old house needs to be removed.

The amendment to the building permit ordinance was presented to the Board. Charlie made a motion to have the ordinance advertised, seconded by Bob. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.

The bills were presented to the Board. Bob made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Charlie. The motion carried. Vote 3-0.
