The Codorus Township Board of Supervisors met on October 4, 2018 at 7:30 P.M. Board members present were: Lamar Glatfelter and Charlie Van Scoyoc. Others present were: April & Dave Rehbein, Carolyn & Steve Bupp, Michael Wickman, Jennifer Webb, Matt Bollinger, Jim Bailey Adam Keller and Attorney Paul Minnich.

The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

The minutes were approved as presented.

April Rehbein & Carolyn Bupp are recording the meeting.

Under public comments Michael Wickham of Snyder Mill Road reported the following: Heavy trucks are still using Snyder Mill Road, Ross Paving is dumping asphalt and other material without a permit, illegal fuel containers are being used by Ross Paving, OSHA violations with welders and large equipment and dumping violation of asphalt shavings and other materials on property located at 5173 Snyder Mill Rd. Since Bob isn't at the meeting tonight the Supervisors will discuss the issues with Bob and investigate the problems reported.

Adam Keller presented the final plan for Hillandale. The Planning Commission approved the plan at last months meeting. Charlie made a motion to approve and sign the plan, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.

Jennifer Webb is the Library Board Treasurer for the Glen Rock Library. She reported that expenses are up for the library. She reported that Codorus Township residents are using the library and would like to request that the Township double the current donation of \$880.00 per year. Lamar said the Township will look at the numbers in the budget.

Matt Bollinger is a Supervisor at Heidelberg Township. He is present on behalf of the Southwestern Regional Police Department. He gave a presentation on the police department and would like to offer a contract to Codorus Township.

The bills were presented to the Board. Charlie made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Lamar. The motion carried. Vote 2-0.
